the territory

The territory of Menfi, located on the south-west coast of Sicily, is rich in biodiversity: numerous exposures, slopes, altitudes, sea breezes and sunbeams make it extremely suitable for quality viticulture. Here, Mandrarossa has found a micro region characterised by 100% limestone soils, generating unique wines that are strongly region distinctive.













the study of the soils

the project

Since 2014 an international team of agronomists and soil experts, together with Mandrarossa enologists, have carried out a scientific study on limestone soils and this has defined them a micro region with a high quality potential. The mapping of these soils has revealed wonderful vineyards where it is possible to grow local grapes generating wines such as "Bertolino Soprano" and "Terre del Sommacco", the new wines of Mandrarossa Contrada.







the wine

It is produced from Nero D'Avola single-variety grapes growing in vineyards located on limestone soils, hand-picked in September 2016. The land benefits from the sea breezes that, combined with the consistency of the soil, gives the wine minerality, intense aroma and character. The refinement in French oak barrels makes it embracing, velvety and aromatically complex. The red berries and the marasca cherry, with delicate spicy notes, make it a wine with a strong personality.





the concept



Bertolino Soprano 2017 originates from single-variety Grillo grapes produced in Bertolino Soprano contrada, from which it takes its name, hand-picked in August 2017. The limestone soil gives freshness and elegance to the wine, while the refinement in French oak barrels makes it soft, intense and persistent. Floral, zesty, with a herbaceous finish, it expresses all the character of the land on which it was generated, selected for its unique characteristics.
